Training Session for Catechists On How to Use This Program

Training Objective:

The purpose of this resource is to provide catechetical leaders with a detailed outline for training catechists to implement the *Teaching Safety: Empowering God's Children Program* in the classroom. While this resource provides a structured format for presenting the material, it is flexible enough for the catechetical leader to adapt its contents to the unique needs and special circumstances of their parish situation.

In order to implement the *Teaching Safety: Empowering God's Children Program* catechists will need to:

- learn about the program (both the Program Overview and the individual Class Lesson)
- be informed where to find the appropriate materials
- be taught to facilitate a lesson for their grade level

The process and method of such training is at the discretion of the catechetical leader.

Catechetical Leader Presentation Script

A. Opening Prayer

B. <u>Diocese of Rockford updates the Christian Chastity and Safe Environment Program</u>

Share with the catechists the following background information.

Bishop Malloy has approved a new program to replace the current *Christian Chastity and Safe Environment Program for Children* with the *Teaching Safety: Empowering God's Children Program*. The previous program has been in use since 2009 and the new program will be implemented beginning in the Fall of 2019.

There are many benefits to this new program, such as:

- There are easy-to-follow lessons with little preparation.
- There is only one lesson per year.
- There is a consistent format and timeframe for every grade level.
- There is the possibility of consolidating classes.
- There is an improved focus on safety.
- There are updated activities.

C. Important Considerations/Changes for this New Program

1. Considerations for the New Program

There are two important points for planning and implementing this program in our parish:

- We must provide the *Teaching Safety: Empowering God's Children Program* to our religious education students **before December 1.**
 - All catechists teaching this class need to know how to use the lesson plans.

2. Changes for the New Program

In the Teaching Safety: Empowering God's Children Program there are:

- Lesson Plans that only address the safe environment topic.
 - Chastity is not part of this teaching safety program, but is covered throughout the year in the parish program.
- Formats for training every grade are divided into four units.
 - ➤ Pre K will continue to use the *Birthday Suit* book.
 - ➤ K-2, will use the new lesson plans.
 - > 3-5 will use the new lesson plans.
 - ➤ 6-8 will use the new lesson plans.
- Lesson plans are on a three-year cycle.

D. Everything a Catechist needs to Know to Prepare and Teach the Lesson

In order to become familiar with this program and all of our responsibilities, catechists will participate in a brief training session that will include:

- 1. Preparation before teaching Teaching Safety: Empowering God's Children Program
- 2. Lesson Day
 - Classroom Prep Work
 - Teaching the Lesson
 - Responsibilities Before Leaving
